


### Present perfect vs Past simple

What is the difference?

Past Simple	Present Perfect
<p>Before Ahmed <b>came</b> to our city, he <b>was</b> in Jordan.</p> <p>His mum <b>got</b> a new job, so the family <b>moved</b> here.</p> <p>When I <b>met</b> Ahmed, he <b>knew</b> nothing about Jerusalem.</p>	<p>My friend Andrew <b>has lived</b> in this city for five years.</p> <p>We <b>have been</b> best friends since then.</p> <p>His dad says he <b>has learned</b> a lot from me.</p>
